*Senior group: Those born between 01/01/1995 and 31/12/1999

*The competition will be held in 2 rounds.

First Round: Each participant will deliver a prepared speech on one of the three designated topics. The speech should be 3 to 4 minutes long for juniors, and 4 -5 minutes for seniors. Second Round: Top participants from each category in the first round will participate in the second round, in which they will deliver an impromptu speech. Topics will be drawn randomly from the list. Participants will have 10 minutes to prepare and the speech should not exceed 2 minutes for juniors or 3 minutes for seniors.
